Theory Programs

The crane training school features a strong grounding in theory related to inspection, power-line safety, theory and site hazards involved in crane operation. Individuals training would gain knowledge of rigging, hardware applications and load charts. Quizzes and direct feedback during the course would help individuals training solidify their understanding.

Theory course topics: Introduction to crane certification process; safety fundamentals for crane operators; crane operation knowledge; rigging knowledge; communications knowledge; crane service and maintenance and crane set-up and pre-trip inspections.

Practical Programs

The practical training section of the crane training school emphasizes hands-on learning. This part of the course focuses on the identification and terminology of crane components. Trainees would have the opportunity to practice skills needed for crane operating, signaling and rigging.

Practical course topics: Identify crane components and functions; Learn crane terminology; identify rigging and wire ropes; use remote control; pre-use check on crane; identify documents and regulations for rigging and wire rope; carry out rigging techniques; use hand signals and radio; and perform correct lowering and lifting of loads.
