Crane License Victoria - The crane operator has to have been certified with a crane operator license or certification. To be able to practice as an operator of a crane, the qualifications are considered mandatory. Having a license involves training and final assessment and examination.

In order to operate whatever type of heavy machine including cranes, the operator requires safety training. Crane operator license training combines the on-the-job supervised work and specialized training programs. These training programs are provided by industry training and certification organizations. The content of training programs for crane operators could vary depending on local industry requirements and laws.

The certification and training can be offered by different kinds of cranes: mobile cranes, overhead cranes, articulator cranes and tower cranes. The overhead crane is made use of rather often in manufacturing. Mobile cranes transport heavy machinery to places where the task must be done. Articulator cranes are used in order to load machines and materials onto truck beds and various heavy equipment. The biggest kind of crane is the Tower cranes, typically located in huge sea ports.

The crane department supervisor would usually have the authority to offer basic hands-on crane training, within the manufacturing business. Following the practical part, the trainee might need to pass a course. Upon successful completion of the course, the trainee would be certified or licensed.

Simulated crane operator training is provided in some industrial environments, which allow operators the ability to gain hands-on skills without putting other employees and equipment at danger. The simulated environment provides a set of virtual activities utilizing a simulated crane, such as realistic controls. By mastering crane operation during simulated training, the operator could operate real cranes on the job.

When licensed and certified, crane operators must take part in continuing education to regularly upgrade their knowledge and skills. Continuous crane operator training is usually suggested for technicians so they can stay abreast of updates in crane technology and safety features.
