Telehandler Certification Victoria - A telehandler certification course can be taken by potential operators who have prior experience with driving standard forklifts and for individuals with no previous experiences on a lift truck. The real-world training provided by these programs produces graduates who know the correct and safe use of these types of machinery.

Telehandler certification courses could be finished at a third party location or at the work site of the trainees. In order to get the formal training at a certain training facility, the manufacturer can work out a licensing agreement in order to bring other people to a training facility. This alternative provides those training with the chance to learn to use the equipment in a controlled setting. When finished, people who participated receive a license or certification to operate this type of machine.

With the latter alternative, a skilled instructor is sent to a work place to provide on-location training. This option ensures that the trainee is instructed on actual machine which will be used on the job, and prepares the trainee for the demands of that particular environment. Trainees learn about possible dangerous cases that could happen on the actual work site. The instruction focuses on any situation that are specific to the work location, enabling operators to be prepared to deal with these elements more safely.

The term "telehandler" is an abbreviated version of "telescopic handler," meaning an equipment that has an extending or telescoping arm supporting a fork. A telehandler has various characteristics and controls just like a forklift. A telehandler has the capability of lifting and transporting loads up and away from the vehicle. Wrong use of telehandlers could lead to serious accidents. If load limits are exceeded, the equipment could tip because of excess weight on the lift. It is an operator's responsibility to understand load restrictions and to safely utilize these machinery.

Telehandler programs designed for operators who are already certified to make use of a forklift are called "conversion" classes. These classes teach the differences between telehandlers and forklifts, and avoid repeating information which forklift operators already know. For trainees who have no past experience using telehandler machines, training covers the basic operation and use of the equipment. Some groups offer refresher programs as well.
