The checklist below is essential for whichever workplace which has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions should be answered with "yes" if all the safety rules and regulations are being followed. A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw that may lead to damage to machinery, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are changes to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) The lift truck tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift certification and inspection done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed job?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators read and understand the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work right?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted right?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Have all lift truck operators acquired certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all types of forklifts being operated?
- 22) Do operators know their duties to report any machine damage and forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the equipment being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each day?
