Therefore, companies place a top priority on warehouse safety.

The key to preventing accidents is understanding all of the potential warehouse hazards. Finds ways to lessen risks and always be alert for potential dangers and hazards. Do whatever is necessary to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are usually caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over an item which has not been put away properly. Removing or placing stuff from storage could result in a slip or fumble, potentially causing both worker and item to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when employees are moving materials on various types of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack things on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are another common danger.

Warehouse machinery carries inherent dangers. Injuries or accidents can be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, such as skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, need to be utilized carefully during loading, packing and unpacking.

Hazardous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose danger while being stored in a warehouse. Employees must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around dangerous materials.
